

Making the Impossible Possible: The Road to The First-In-Human Kidney Xenotransplant Clinical Trial

Xenotransplantation aims to increase availability through the novel approach of transplanting, implanting, or infusing live cells, tissues, organs from a nonhuman animal source, however, there are many clinical and ethical consdirations that must be examined as we look towards to the future.
